## Measures for Space Rental Service during COVID-19 Situation

Following the fourth phase of COVID-19 relief measures which were announced on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020, Bangkok Art and Culture Centre now resumes our space rental service under certain precautionary measures to reassure the safety of all visitors. Therefore, we would like to ask for cooperation from the organizers on the following issues.

- 1. Limit the number of people in each space according to this guideline.
- Multi-function Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor (Size : 350 square meter / Limited to 100 people)
- Auditorium, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size: 270 square meter / Limited to 150 people)
- Studio, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size : 380 square meter / Limited to 100 people)
- Friends of bacc, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor (Approximate Size : 120 square meter / Limited to 50 people)
- Meeting Room 501, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size: 80 square meter / Limited to 20 people)
- Meeting Room 502, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size : 40 square meter / Limited to 10 people)
- Meeting Room 401, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size : 70 square meter / Limited to 20 people)
- Meeting Room 402, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor (Size: 27 square meter / Limited to 6 people)
- 2. For on ground exhibition opening events, BACC reserves the right to limit the number of participants according to the size of the space. All participants must keep at least 1 meter distance from each other.
- 3. The organizer must provide registration for participants along with their contact numbers and submit the list to BACC within 1-3 days after the event.
- 4. The organizer must submit a safety plan and provide hand sanitizers for the event. BACC only provides temperature check and hand sanitizer at the building entrances.
- 5. The organizers must strictly comply with BACC's space usage regulations and our COVID-19 precautionary measures including social distancing and wearing a mask in the building.

The measure applies until further update from the CCSA and BMA.
